My older son started in year 7 this September. It has been great to see him settling in so well and enjoying the transition to EWS. I also have a younger son (in year 5 at primary school) who will also follow onto EWS in a couple of years.

I would love to be part of the development of the school in the long term and believe becoming a parent governor at EWS would be both a challenging and rewarding opportunity.

In my current role as Head of Support Services for a Multi-Academy Trust, I oversee all support functions for schools in the Trust including HR & Recruitment, Finance & Payroll, Governance & Compliance, Families & Engagement, IT, Procurement, and Health and Safety.

I believe my experience and skills are highly transferrable to this role and I would utilise these to have a meaningful impact within the school and its strategic development.

After a difficult two years for children in education, I would love to work closely with EWS to understand what mental health support is in place and the development of this alongside support for children with special educational needs.

I would bring a lot of energy and enthusiasm to this important role of parent governor and would play a keen role in ensuring the parent voice was heard.
