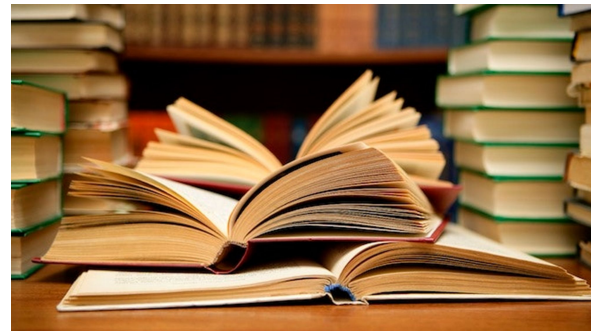
- 75% of students with attendance rates of 96% and above achieve at least five or more 9-5 grades at GCSE.
- At 90% attendance, students have only a 35% chance of five or more 9-5 grades at GCSE.
- Students with 8/9s at GCSE will earn £350,000 more over a lifetime on average than students who gain grade 4s

Why Read?

- Research by Longdean in 2022 shows that reading is good for your mental health and can prevent dementia in later life.
- Research shows that reading can increase your life expectancy by 2 years
- Research by Kirsch in 1986 shows that reading 20 minutes a day can improve standardised test scores (including GCSEs) by 30%

Our Expectations:

- Students read at home at least 10 minutes per day
- At school the new EWS reads programme will ensure students read regularly. Books selected reflect modern day issues alongside classical texts.

Bus pass scheme for non-entitled students...

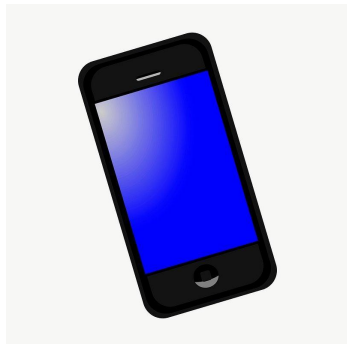
