Dear Parents/Carers

The final few weeks of term are approaching swiftly, as always it is busy at EWS. There are some important events and changes happening over the next few weeks, with further details below.

Timetable

The timetable will change on July 4th with all students having a new timetable and Year 9 starting their option choices; this timetable will be similar to the one on their return to school after the summer break. There are increased hours in Science at Key stage 4 (years 9 and 10) to allow for Triple Science to be studied by those students we assess to be suitable for this course. Science staff will communicate more details about this at the start of the next academic year.

Catch-Up Intervention

We will be running some catch-up intervention sessions over the last few weeks of term; these include Science days for Year 8 and Year 10, Maths drop-down days for Year 10 and English days for Year 9. Parents of students involved in these days will be contacted with more details.

Visits

We have a year 9 Battlefields trip going out to Belgium this week as well as UCAS trip for year 12 students.

Work experience

Year 10 and 12 students will be out for work experience during the last week of term, please speak to your child's head of year if you have any questions or concerns.

Last day of term/Sports Day

The last day of term is Friday 22nd July, we will be having our Sports day in the morning and students will be dismissed at 1.30pm. Transport companies have been notified.

Behaviour system

We have been working with our partner school in London (Ashmole Academy) to review our systems. This year we amended the policy to include a senior leadership detention on a Friday after school.
