Why study this course?

A-Level Spanish not only allows students to further develop their Spanish language skills, but also explores sociocultural issues, life and art in Hispanic countries. The course opens the door to university degrees related to Spanish language and culture, and forms a foundation for further linguistic studies.

How you will learn

A-Level Spanish lessons combine all the elements required to be a successful linguist. We build grammar skills, focus on speaking, listening, reading and writing, and use the Spanish language to discuss sociocultural issues, literature and film. Regular formative assessment is used to monitor student progress and ensure they are ready to succeed in their exams.

External exams at the end of the course of study. Ongoing formative assessment by teachers throughout the programme.
