Dear Year 11 Parents and Carers,

We have been impressed with how hard Year 11 have been working in the weeks leading up to their exams, and we commend them for their impeccable behaviour in the exam hall so far.

During period 5 on Friday, straight after lunch, we will be holding a final assembly for Year 11 on both sites when we will celebrate their time with us over the past 5 years. Students will be allowed to sign shirts during this lesson only; we will also enjoy some cakes and a few words from their tutors and Heads of Year. Students who do not catch a bus may be allowed to leave at 14:45.

If your son/daughter needs to catch the bus to travel to and from school, we will open up supervised quiet study areas for them to go and work in during the day when they are not in an exam or revision session.
